A credit is defined as the completion of a class which meets for a full semester. To earn a diploma from Leavenworth Senior High School students must earn a minimum of 23 credits. Specific course requirements are listed below.

- Algebra I or Equivalent
- Geometry
- Other

Science (3 credits)

- Biology
- Physical Science (Environmental Science or Chemistry)
- Other

PE (2 credits)

- Freshman PE and Health
- Other (PE or JROTC)

Practical Art (.5 credit)

- Computer Technology/Business
- Family and Consumer Science
- Technology Education

Electives (6.5 credits/9.5 credits beginning with class of 2023)
