

Remote Learning for Second Semester

- Rigorous Remote students will be enrolled in four core courses (in two instructional time blocks - one in the morning from 7:50 a.m - 10:25 a.m. and one in the afternoon from 12:30 p.m. - 3 p.m.)
 - If a student is currently enrolled in an AP (Advanced Placement), Concurrent/Dual (College Credit) or Direct Instruction Special Education (Applied and Life Skills Classes), students will continue to zoom with their current teacher.
 - If a student failed a core course during the first semester, that course will need to be passed in Edgenuity before being allowed to move on to the second semester of that course.
- Grades will be recorded in PowerSchool weekly. The grade reported will be the “Relative Grade”. This grade is the grade that a student would receive if s/he stopped working and received 0% for all unscored, counted activities.
- Students must attend Advisory daily and check-in at a pre-scheduled time with their Rigorous Remote facilitating teacher, for the purpose of attendance.
- Students are expected to complete and pass eight semester classes or four credits per semester in order to ensure that they remain on-track for graduation.
- Tutoring for each core area (English, Math, Social Studies, and Science) will be offered during the spring semester and more information will be provided at a later date.
- Students will be able to access Edgenuity at: www.edgenuity.com (Google Chrome is the recommended web browser.) Upon selection of Rigorous Remote Learning, students will be provided directions on how to access their Edgenuity account. They will use their LHS student ID credentials.
